

## **Questions for Discussion and Reflection**

**Sunday, June 19, 2022**

**James 3:13-18**

We've provided these questions to give families or groups (of all ages) and individuals an opportunity to reflect on today's message. We hope you'll use them over lunch or dinner today, or with your Life Group, to consider more fully the teaching of James 3:13-18.

1. Who is someone in your life that you would consider to be wise? What qualities do they possess that make you identify them as a wise person?
2. What problems do we encounter when we seek to correct our wrongful behavior solely through our own will power? As a follower of Jesus, how does the gospel apply to your need for change?
3. Why does James equate true wisdom to our actions, as opposed to the knowledge that we possess?
4. What lies at the root of the wisdom from the world? Why can this wisdom become so appealing or persuasive?
5. How have you witnessed the destructive results of worldly wisdom impact our culture? How have you seen its results impact your own life?
6. How can we receive wisdom from God? What are some adjustments that you might need to make in order to walk in the wisdom of God?
7. In what specific way(s) will you be seeking for God to produce a righteous harvest in your life and in your relationships in the coming days?
