James 1:12-18

We've provided these questions to give families or groups (of all ages) and individuals an opportunity to reflect on today's message. We hope you'll use them over lunch or dinner today, or with your Life Group, to consider more fully the teaching of James 1:12-18.

1. What temptations are you regularly battling (or giving in to) at the moment?
2. How/why do trials seem to intensify those temptations?
3. How does this passage change the way you view those temptations?
4. Which of these three application statements seem most necessary and relevant to you right now?
 - a. Hate all sin, but especially your own.
 - b. Kill sin early, before it is too late.
 - c. Let a great awareness of your sinfulness fuel a great joy in Jesus Christ.
5. How does the description of God in verses 17-18 motivate you to resist those temptations? How does it reassure you when you fail?
